### **3. PRESENTATION – Acknowledgement of successful completion by youth participating in the Housing and Community Development Department's Summer Youth Program.**

#### **2006 Summer Youth Program Overview**

The City of Bradenton Housing and Community Development department has completed another successful Summer Youth Program.

The Summer Youth Program started with Student Orientation night on June 8<sup>th</sup> 2006. Thirteen students were accepted to the program this year, and there was 100 % attendance including parents or guardian from each family. The Orientation was held at the Manatee County public library.

Students started a 20-hour workweek on June 12, 2006 thru August 4, 2006. There were three City of Bradenton internal departments and seven non-profit organizations that participate in the program this year. Students were interviewed, and then matched to the best fit for the job and personality. There were 12 students that finished the program completely, and with great praise from all supervisors involved.

I believe this was a successful learning experience and would like to thank all the internal departments and non-profit business that took place in this year's program to make it such a success.
