

**SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
September 10, 2004**

The City of Bradenton City Council met in special session in the Gene Gallo Central Fire Station, 1010 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue West, Bradenton, Florida on September 10, 2004 at 1:30 p.m.

Mayor Poston read the following resolution:

**RESOLUTION NO. 04-40**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA, DECLARING THAT THE THREAT OF A DISASTER EMERGENCY IS IMMINENT AND THAT THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PRACTICES AND PROVISIONS OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON SHALL BE INSTITUTED; PROVIDING THE CITY SHALL COMPLY WITH AND OPERATE UNDER ALL FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY RULES AND GUIDELINES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**
