A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) CLOSE THE NORTH BOUND LANES OF THE GREEN BRIDGE DURING A POWERBOAT REGATTA TAKING PLACE IN FEBRUARY, 2015, AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR PERMIT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY CLOSING FOR SPECIAL USE OF STATE ROADS PERMIT APPLICATION NECESSARY FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSING AND FORMALLY AUTHORIZING THE POWERBOAT REGATTA EVENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
