

ORDINANCE NO. 2967

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION II, SUBDIVISION 1 AND SUBDIVISION 2, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON BY DECLARING AND ESTABLISHING THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON AS THE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FOR THE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AREAS OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bradenton, Florida did pursuant to Resolution 79-55, establish a Community Redevelopment Area as set forth in said Resolution, as amended by Resolution 80-39 removing certain properties from the Community Redevelopment Area and as amended by Resolution 81-62 clarifying boundaries for the Community Redevelopment Area and as amended by Ordinance 2923 expanding the boundaries the Community Redevelopment Area; such area being commonly described as and known as the Downtown Community Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 93-62 the City Council of the City of Bradenton, Florida established a second Community Redevelopment Area commonly described as and known as The 14th Street Community Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bradenton, Florida in Ordinance 2219 pursuant to Florida Statute 163.357 conferred the powers of a Community Redevelopment Agency upon the Bradenton Downtown Development Authority; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 00-39, the City Council of the City of Bradenton, Florida, created a third Community Redevelopment Area as set forth in said Resolution commonly known as The Central Community Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2628 passed on July 12, 2000, the City Council did create a Community Redevelopment Agency known as the Central Community Redevelopment Agency to act as the agency for the Central Community Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bradenton, Florida desires to repeal the provisions of Ordinance No. 2265 conferring the powers of a Community Redevelopment Agency upon the Downtown Development Authority as set forth in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Bradenton, Florida as Section 2, subdivision 1 and to

repeal provisions of Ordinance No. 2628 as set forth in Section 2, subdivision 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Bradenton, Florida creating The Central Community Redevelopment Agency and declare itself as the Community Redevelopment Agency for all Community Redevelopment Areas of the City of Bradenton; and

WHEREAS, Section 163.357 of Florida Statute provides that the governing body of the City may, at any time, declare itself as the Community Redevelopment Agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. Section. 2 Subsections 1 and 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City Bradenton, which conferred powers of a Community Redevelopment Agency upon the Bradenton Downtown Development Authority and created the Central Community Redevelopment Agency are hereby repealed in their entirety and in its place a new Subdivision 1 is adopted to provide as follows in this Ordinance.

Section 2. Pursuant to Florida Statute 163.356 there is hereby created a public body, corporate and politic to be known as the Community Redevelopment Agency.

Section 3. Pursuant to Florida Statute 163.357 and City Resolution, the City Council of the City of Bradenton, Florida, shall serve as the governing body of the Community Redevelopment Agency.


Section 4. The Community Redevelopment Agency shall be governed by and act in conformity with the provisions of the general law and this Ordinance as shall be amended from time to time and may adopt rules and procedures it may deem appropriate from time to time to govern its meetings and carry out its duties and powers.

Section 5. The area of operation of the Community Redevelopment Agency shall be the redevelopment areas as set forth in Resolution 79-55, as amended and Resolution 93-62 and Resolution 00-39.

This Ordinance shall take effect on the 1st day of January, ~~2015~~ ²⁰¹⁶.
