The City of Bradenton Police Department proposes to use its 2016-17 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Formula Program funds in the amount of \$26,550 as means to acquire law enforcement equipment and initiate supplemental street level and covert investigations.
