

**NEW BUSINESS BY DEPARTMENT HEADS, CITY ATTORNEY, AND CITY COUNCIL**

**Carl Callahan, City Clerk & Treasurer**

- a. Request to accept the land transfer of 48<sup>th</sup> Street Court East from County to City jurisdiction and to execute all necessary documents.

Bill Lisch stated that the entryway into the subdivision needed to be added into the surrounding city property to prevent problems with law enforcement jurisdiction issues. In addition, an agreement had been reached with the Tidewater Preserve Master Association to maintain the landscaping of the entryway.

**MOTION TO APPROVE THE LAND TRANSFER OF 48<sup>th</sup> Street Court East from County to City and authorize the Mayor to execute all necessary documents was made by Vice Mayor/Councilman Smith, seconded by Councilman Roff, and approved 5:0.**

**MOTION TO APPROVE THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION was made by Vice Mayor/Councilman Smith, seconded by Councilman Roff, and approved 5:0.**

- b. Funding for Manatee County Historical Park – Impact Fees – East

Mr. Callahan requested approval to designate funding from impact fees east in the amount of \$8,961.00 for playground equipment for Manatee County Historical Park.

**MOTION TO APPROVE UTILIZATION OF IMPACT FEES in the amount of \$8,961.00 for the purchase of playground equipment for Manatee County Historical Park was made by Councilman Byrd, seconded by Vice Mayor/Councilman Smith, and approved 5:0.**

Mr. Callahan said that approximately \$43,000 in funding was needed for the proposed enhancements to Love Park, with \$5,000 to come from the CCRA, \$8,500 from a grant, and the balance from impact fees. This would complete the circle of revamping all of our parks.

**MOTION TO APPROVE UTILIZATION OF IMPACT FEES for improvements to Love Park was made by Councilman Byrd, seconded by Councilman Roff, and approved 5:0.**

**COUNCIL REPORTS**

**Councilman Gene Gallo, Ward I:** Nothing to report.

**Councilman Gene Brown, Ward II:** Had attended the board meeting of the Bradenton Housing Authority and, as had been discussed at the previous council meeting, had offered city assistance in any way which would be needed. Councilman Brown felt that the board was moving forward in a good direction.

**Councilman Patrick Roff, Ward III:** Announced there would be a public meeting on Wednesday, January 29<sup>th</sup>, to garner feedback from the citizens regarding possible uses of city-owned properties in the Ballard Park neighborhood.

**Vice Mayor/Councilman Bemis Smith, Ward IV:** Nothing to report.

**Councilman Harold Byrd, Jr., Ward V:** Nothing to report.
