



## NOTICE OF A SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE CITY OF BRADENTON'S COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) 2012-2013 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

Notice is hereby given that the City of Bradenton is proposing a substantial amendment to its 2012-2013 Annual Action Plan for the Community Development Block Grant Program. The City has approximately \$43,675.36 available in unobligated program funds that it wishes to obligate to the following projects:

The City is proposing to use these funds to rehabilitate single family homes owned by low and moderate-income families within the City limits, and is soliciting citizen input and comments on the proposed use of funds. The public comment period will commence November 12, 2012 and end December 12, 2012.
