- III. Women's Council of Realtors is looking to raise awareness for Feeding Empty Little Tummys. They provide backpacks full of food to children at risk of not eating over the weekend. They are planning less than 200 guests and serving cold food. ERC recommended a route that has been successful during past events. They will turn the course earlier so that street closures could be prevented. Chris would like to setup a table and provide water. ERC reminded to the Event Holder that stakes are not permitted in the ground and suggested to walk the route. The Event Holder would like to utilize the Pavilion area. They are planning to have a registration table, Vendors, Food will be boxed lunches for the Participants, and Microphone and Amplifier. Solid Waste services will cost \$50. ERC suggested contacting CSX regarding their event and activities. One Police Officer will be required. The COB fees were discussed with the Event Holder. This event has been approved by ERC.
