### New Events

- Gulfcoast Rhythm and Ribs Music Fest: This is a 3 day event at McKechnie Field and utilizing the Public Works and Utilities parking lot. No road closures are required. This event is on the agenda to go to Council on May 13, 2015.
- Quickest Quacky: The MOT plan was submitted. Rick Parks is reviewing the plan.
- Manatee Glens Walk For Life: begins at Sutton Park and will go over the Green Bridge. They were notified to obtain their own barricades. Cones will be needed for the entire length of the green bridge. Rene will discuss the requirements for the Event Holder to rent barricades and cones. There will be road closures. Additional road closure on 3<sup>rd</sup> is needed as well as the intersection of 10th. Tom is concerned about the crowd at 9<sup>th</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.
