

ERC MEETING MINUTES

OCTOBER 1, 2015

Meeting opened at 9 am.

- I. Event Review and Collaboration
 - a. New Events added to the calendar.
 - i. Art Fair by ArtCenter: Solid Waste services will be determined if provided by City or County. Parking concerns were discussed. Claude will call the Event Coordinator and request they attend one of our events.
 - ii. Snooty Gala: Street closures will be needed. Detour signs are being requested. They are providing their own barricades. The Event Coordinator will need to purchase the signs requested. It is not an item that we have available.
 - iii. Sounds of the Season: the event will be the same as last year. Rene will schedule for Del Couch to attend a meeting to discuss logistics.
 - b. Ghost 5K: 7 Officers will be needed. Tom shared his concerns about timeframe and route. The route for the kids run is needed. The Event Coordinator is responsible for notifying the local businesses that may be impacted. Leo is checking on Police Officers. MOT is needed by Thursday, October 8th. Police final positioning will be determined upon receipt of the MOT. If the MOT is not received by October 8th, the event is in jeopardy of being canceled.
 - c. Grind for Life: the construction of the skate bowl was recently rebid. It will take place after October 24th. The Event Holder is still providing details of the event. They might pull their RV up and power is needed.
 - d. Toronto Big Band Performance: 22 people on stage, January 25th or February 21st. If they want to reserve the space, the rental fee is required.
 - e. Walk for Life: Solid Waste is unable to make communication with the Event Holder after several attempts.
 - f. Gulfcoast Rhythm Ribs Fest: The roll off might need to be switched out. Brian will contact the Event Holder regarding any City services required. ERC has been told that the Pirates will be providing all services. October 9th, Executive vehicles may need to be parked in the yard.
 - g. Courthouse Concerts: the County will be providing services. Four parking spaces have been reserved at 12th and Manatee.
- II. Public Works and Utilities
 - a. Riverwalk came in a little under budget.
 - b. Amphitheater stairs is being planned.

- c. Trimming is done from the Green Bridge to the playground. It's currently being mulched.
 - d. We are waiting for lighting supplies.
 - e. The banners were re-stitched, although, a bit faded.
- III. DDA
 - a. We should plan for the Regatta Event Holder to come to an ERC meeting to discuss logistics of the event.
- IV. Realize Bradenton
 - a. The Market's is starting. Portolets will be dropped off next to the GTE building.
 - b. Courthouse Concerts start on Monday.
- V. Miscellaneous Items
 - a. Vendors at Riverwalk: City Council will need to make a decision regarding this item.
 - b. Routes for Runs/Walks: Two routes have been established. It will be added to the manual and given to Event Coordinators. Leo will let us know the amount of Officers needed and we will add it to the manual and race standards.
 - c. Charging for rental of other venues for private events: Rene will find out from the County the amount they are charging for other venues. We will analyze the information and apply as necessary based upon the number of requests we receive. This may be an item for Council to discuss.
