

ERC MEETING MINUTES SEPTEMBER 17, 2015

Meeting opened at 9 am.

- I. Event Review and Collaboration
 - a. Walk to End Alzheimers: 1 Officer needed.
 - b. Gulfcoast Rhythm & Ribs Fest: Public Works services are not needed because they will be working with the Pirates on the clean-up, however, the application indicates that Solid Waste services are needed. Clarification for Public Works services are needed. Brian will be calling them. 6 Officers will be needed.
 - c. Sister Schools Fiesta: Solid Waste services are all set. This is going before Council.
 - d. Courthouse Concert: No City services are required.
 - e. Pop Ups for a Purpose: No City services are required.
 - f. Ghost 5k Run/Walk: MOT is required. ERC must receive the MOT plan including barricade placement completed by September 24, 2015 or the event will be cancelled. They are planning to revise their map. Kelly in PD will need to be aware of the new route to determine the amount of Officers required. We also need clarification regarding whether or not there is a Main Street Live afterwards.
 - g. An organization is interested in doing a 5k with a timing company. We need more information regarding who will be taking responsibility for race organization.
- II. Public Works and Utilities
 - a. Riverwalk has been pressure washed.
 - b. A piece of broken playground equipment has been removed for safety.
 - c. 9/11 event was successful.
 - d. Fall maintenance of weeding, trimming and mulch will begin soon at Riverwalk.
 - e. Skate bowl construction will begin soon.
 - f. 95% of Riverwalk has been sprayed.
 - g. There hasn't been any vandalism in the past week at Riverwalk.
- III. DDA
 - a. The Herald today mentioned that a boat taxi wants to run from the Island to Riverwalk day dock. The group has not yet spoken with the DDA. This would also need to be reviewed by Council.
