

## ERC MEETING MINUTES

### JUNE 26, 2014

Attendance: Dave Gustafson, Mindy Piantanida, Gary Kinder, Brian Henry, Curtis Johnson, Kenny Simunovic, Holly Lundgren, Claude Tankersley, Tom Orehowsky, Deanna Levingood (Twilight 5k), Mike Lavalliere (Twilight 5k), and Doug Schiller (Twilight 5k).

Meeting officially opened at 9:05 am

- I. Post Event Review: All events were successful.
- II. Collaboration on Upcoming Events
  - a. Tom Orehowsky discussed Runs/Walks: The St. Joseph's run will follow the same route as the Pirates and Princesses since it was successful.
    - i. Race Concerns for Twilight 5K: There are safety concerns since it will be dark outside. The date and time might need to be modified. ERC requested Tom to provide requirements since he is the Professional for successful and safe runs. More police and volunteers will be needed at all intersections for the safety of the runners. The Jingle Bell run is the only run that can cross 9<sup>th</sup> since it's a DOT road. The time of day/day of the week is a concern for local businesses including show times at Manatee Players, dinner and events at Pier 22, etc. Tom educated the team that CSX will not guarantee any stops along the way.
- III. Public Works Updates
  - a. July 4<sup>th</sup>: Gary has 8 signs stating "No fireworks, no open flames". There will not be Public Works services during the event due to the inability to move trash through the crowd. Old Main Street will remain open. Green bridge closing plans were discussed. Bradenton PD and Palmetto PD are working together to make July 4<sup>th</sup> a safe event.
  - b. Cigarette Litter: An email was sent to Ingrid regarding color choices (silver with black poles). A request was placed for 40 at Riverwalk and 20 for Main St.
  - c. Ladder: Dave will be discussing it further with Renee Hudson.
  - d. Drinking Fountains: They are vandalized on a consistent basis and have not currently been replaced in various areas.
  - e. Bike Rack: The team thought this would be an excellent addition to Riverwalk Park.
  - f. Skate Park: The pressure washing price quote is \$1,450. Public Works will be getting a price quote on cleaning and repairing graffiti for the Police department.
  - g. The sod was completed today and the fence will go up Friday.
- IV. Twilight 5K Ghost Run/Walk: The purpose of the run is for the organization Robinson Heart and Mind Foundation to raise funds for Autism. They are planning a pub crawl and drivers to take people home if they are incapable of driving. They are planning for the runs to be completed by 6 pm which will be prior to dusk. Roads will be re-open by 6:10 pm. The route, concerns for road closures, and concern for the potential of safety issues were discussed. Police would be approximately 25 Officers for 2 hours at \$35 per hour. ERC suggested they follow the course that Pirates and Princesses followed because it was a safe event. They plan to setup at 3 pm on Saturday and the race time is 4:30 pm. They asked about a stage. ERC educated the Event Holder that more Police Officers will be needed for the nighttime road closures along with Solid Waste services. ERC would like the Event Holder to review the Pirates and Princesses course to consider as a safer path. The date is changed to Saturday, October 18, 2014. They will need to

notify local businesses and residents. They will review the course and will return to the ERC meeting on July 3<sup>rd</sup> at 10 am.

V. Police Dept. Updates:

- a. PD offered to help PW by reviewing camera footage for any vandalism at RW.
- b. Weight limit on pier needs to be reviewed.
- c. RSS came through with their 3<sup>rd</sup> IPAD.
- d. Maintenance contract for existing cameras is being worked on.
- e. We have an influx of homeless people lately.

VI. Rene

- a. Riverwalk Exercise Group is a for profit group on public property. Bill Lisch will further research.
- b. Worship group every Friday at 8:30 pm: All requirements of events are necessary including 1 Police Officer and insurance. They would need to pay each time similar to Music in the Park.



Base cost	\$80	\$80	\$235
Variable cost (per banner)	\$10	\$10	\$20

If company "A" wants to install seven (7) banners on Old Main, then it would cost  $\$80 + 6 * \$10 = \$140$  (\$280 for put up and take down).

If company "B" wants to install 20 banners on Riverwalk, then it would cost  $\$80 + 20 * \$10 = \$280$  (\$560 for put up and take down).

If company "C" wants 16 banners on Riverwalk, 10 on Old Main and 22 on Manatee Ave, then it would cost  $(\$80 + 16 * \$10) + (\$80 + 10 * \$10) + (\$235 + 22 * \$20) = \$1,095$  (\$2,190 for put up and take down).

The increased base and variable costs for Manatee Ave is a result of the equipment and safety requirements to work on a state road.
