ORDINANCE 2950 LU.13.00052 TEXT AMENDMENT

FIRST READING AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON AMENDING THE CITY LAND USE REGULATIONS SECTIONS 3.4.3-FLOOD ZONE AND THOSE PORTIONS OF CHAPTER 10-DEFINITION AS THEY RELATE TO FLOOD ZONES AND SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS.
