

ORDINANCE NO. 2982

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA, REPEALING CHAPTER 2, DIVISION 3, SECTIONS 2-126 THROUGH 2-130 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES WHICH DIVISION ESTABLISHED THE ENTERPRISE ZONE DEVELOPMENT AGENCY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bradenton, Florida, previously adopted Chapter 2, Division 3, Sections 2-126 through 2-130 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Bradenton which established an Enterprise Zone Development Agency; and

WHEREAS the Florida Legislature repealed Sections 290.001 through 290-014 of the Florida Statutes, effective December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2015; and

WHEREAS such repeal eliminated the authority and need for an Enterprise Zone Development Agency; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to eliminate any confusion to reviewers of the City Code by repealing that portion of the City Code that provides for the creations of said Agency;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA.


1. Division 3, Sections 2-126 through Section 1-130 of Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Bradenton, Florida is hereby repealed and the Enterprise Zone Development Agency is abolished.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
