

ORDINANCE NO. 2943

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, SECTION 50-36 BY PROHIBITING PARKING IN ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING SPACES OTHER THAN FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF CHARGING SUCH ELECTRIC VEHICLE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Bradenton has established and installed certain charging stations for electric assisted vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the supply of such charging stations is limited; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of such charging station spaces is to be used for charging electric vehicles only.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA.

Section 50-36 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Bradenton, Florida is hereby amended by adding thereto a Subsection (16) to provide as follows:


1. It is unlawful to park any vehicle in any parking space designated as an electric vehicle charging station except for the purposes of charging such vehicle.
2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.




